

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- Players must be 16 years of age or older. Players under 18 must have the waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- At any time during the season, Rahll Activity Center may request proof of eligibility.
- Before participating, players must complete the Zero Tolerance Waiver and have their picture taken.
- Any player may add on to a team during the season, but will be required to pay the full player fee.
- Players may only participate on one team per league.
- Cost will be \$65 per player.
- Players may add onto a team at any time prior to the end of season tournament. They must pay full price.
- Teams must have the same color of jerseys with numbers.

GAME RULES

- Teams playing with illegal players will result in a forfeit.
- A game will be considered a forfeit if one or both teams are not present or do not have the minimum five players required by 5-minutes after the game is scheduled to begin.
- After the game begins, teams may drop below five players due to injuries or fouls.
 - a. Teams may continue to play with as few as two players.
 - b. If a team is leading the game, they may continue with one player.
 - c. If a team is losing the game, they may not continue with one player. The game will be over.
- The game will consist of two 20-minute halves with a running clock. The clock will stop during the last 2-minutes of the second half.
- There will be a 5-minute halftime.
- Each team will have three 45-second timeouts per game.
- In the result of a tied game at the end of regulation, overtime will consists of one 2-minute period with a stopped clock.
 - a. There will only be one overtime period per game. If the score remains a tie, the game will be called a tie.
- The game will begin with a jump-ball. Each team will alternate possession from out of bounds for the duration of the game.
- Three-point shots will be allowed.
- There will be no shot clock.
- A 3-second lane violation will be enforced.
- The five-second closely quarded rule will be enforced.
 - a. If the ball-handler holds or dribbles the ball in their team's frontcourt while closely guarded for 5-seconds, it will result in a violation.
 - b. The defensive team will receive the ball out of bounds, closest to where the violation was committed.

GAME RULES CONT.

- Dunking will not be permitted.
 - a. Violation of this rule will result in suspension from the remainder of that game and the team's next scheduled game.
 - b. Any person or player who dunks or hangs on the rim will be held responsible for any damages and may be suspended until reimbusements have been received.
- Once a team has committed seven personal fouls, the opposing team will be awarded one-and-one bonus free throw shots.
- Once a team has committed 10 personal fouls, the opposing team will be awarded double bonus or two free throw shots.
- Any player receiving two technical fouls will be suspended for the remainder of the game, plus a minimum of one additional game. They must also leave the facility at the time of their second technical foul.
 - a. Individuals may be required to meet with Rahll Activity Center personnel to discuss the future of their participation. Individuals may be subject to a probation period.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- The Code of Conduct applies to parents, coaches/volunteers, spectators, parents, contracted employees, officials, and professional staff.
- Profane, obscene, abusive, degrading/threatening language, gestures and/or taunting in the presence of anyone attending a Rahll Activity Center event is prohibited.
- Do not handle a child/participant in an aggressive or abusive manner.
- Any act of violence is prohibited.
- · Accept the decision of the game officials as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
- Do not knowingly permit an ineligible player to play in any game.
- Please use good sportsmanship.
- The use of drugs, alcohol, vaping, or tobacco in any form is not permitted while attending any Rahll Activity Center event.
- No firearms or weapons will be permitted at any Rahll Activity Center event.

AT ANY TIME, AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF RAHLL ACTIVITY CENTER, VIOLATION OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT IS SUBJECT TO SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION FROM OUR PROGRAM.
